*Finger Lakes International Wine Competition Awards Chateau Tebeau Winery Among Best in
2013*

ROCHESTER, N.Y., March 27, 2013 – Chateau Tebeau Winery has been awarded a Double Gold Medal for their Maison Rouge (Concord, Niagara, Ives Blend) at the 2013 Finger Lakes International Wine Competition (FLIWC). The 13th annual Competition was held at the Rochester Plaza, March 23-24, 2013 in Rochester, NY. Known as the world's largest charitable wine competition, is open to all commercial wineries from all wine-producing countries.

"This year's Finger Lakes International Wine Competition has the most diverse international group of judges ever assembled in the United States to give the entrants the best possible global palate and global opinion." said Peter Parts, event founder. A record 3,502 wines were entered from 880 wineries, 20 countries, 4 Canadian Provinces, and all 50 United States.

The competition judges awarded 100 Double Gold, 174 Gold, 1,204 Silver and 1,327 Bronze medals this year. Special award categories include: the John Rose Award for the best in class Riesling and the Crystal Grape Award for the best in class Icewine. Awards are also given for the highest scoring Double Gold Chardonnay and for the highest scoring Double Gold Cabernet Sauvignon.

David G. Male, of Buffalo, NY, certified international judge, served as the competition chairman, and Ron Dougherty, of Rochester, NY was the Head Judge. A diverse group of 68 renowned national and international judges representing sommeliers, educators, enologists, winemakers, writers, importers, retailers and industry consultants from around the world participated in the two-day competition which took place in Rochester, New York, about 45 minutes from the heart of Upstate New York's Finger Lakes wine region.

Award-winning wines will be featured at several public events following the competition, including the FLIWC Dinner & Auction on May 4, 2013 at the Rochester Plaza Hotel to benefit Camp Good Days and Special Times. Billed as the "best wine dinner in the world," the event attracts more than 800 wine aficionados and collectors. The cost is \$150 per person, \$1,500 for a table of 10.

All proceeds from the competition and subsequent events benefit Camp Good Days and Special Times, a not-for-profit organization dedicated to improving the quality of life for children and families all over the world, whose lives have been touched by cancer and other life-threatening challenges. Located in the heart of New York State's Finger Lakes wine country, the Camp offers residential programs, year-round activities, and events for adults and children.
